




By 2020, electric drive vehicles will be what % of new light-duty vehicle sales?

China Response




U.S. Response






Discussion from Infrastructure and Standards Group (1)

- **Cooperation between U.S. and China on electric vehicle demonstration**
 - U.S. – Los Angeles, China – Shanghai
 - More work needs to be done on common objectives, data to be shared, hardware set to be considered, means of communication
 - Solidify the concept prior to the EVS25 meeting in November in Shenzhen

- **Need for continuing collaboration on standards**
 - DOE support of SAE (U.S.)/CATARC (China) cooperation on standards
 - Support need for compatibility of technologies (DOE/NIST/others)
